

Attention Directors in Training!

Registration is mandatory – starting January 1, 2012

If you haven't already, make sure to contact our Accreditation Manager, Melissa Weeks, the DTRC Chair, Dr. Angelo Arnold, or the DTRC Co-Chair, Dr. Paul Warner to get registered.

Credentialing of a Director by the American Society for Histocompatibility & Immunogenetics has become a more formalized process in recent years. Many Directors-in-Training have questions about the process and the requirements. Registration with the DTRC will start the communication a Director-in-Training needs to gather documentation of education, training, and experience.

Why do you have to register?

The actual training program undertaken by the candidate must be in writing, and be reviewed and pre-approved by the DTRC. Registration starts the process and the time-line documenting training/experience in clinical histocompatibility testing!

All it takes is a simple email, along with an outline of your training plan, letters of support from your mentor(s), a current CV, and foreign equivalency documentation, if necessary.
